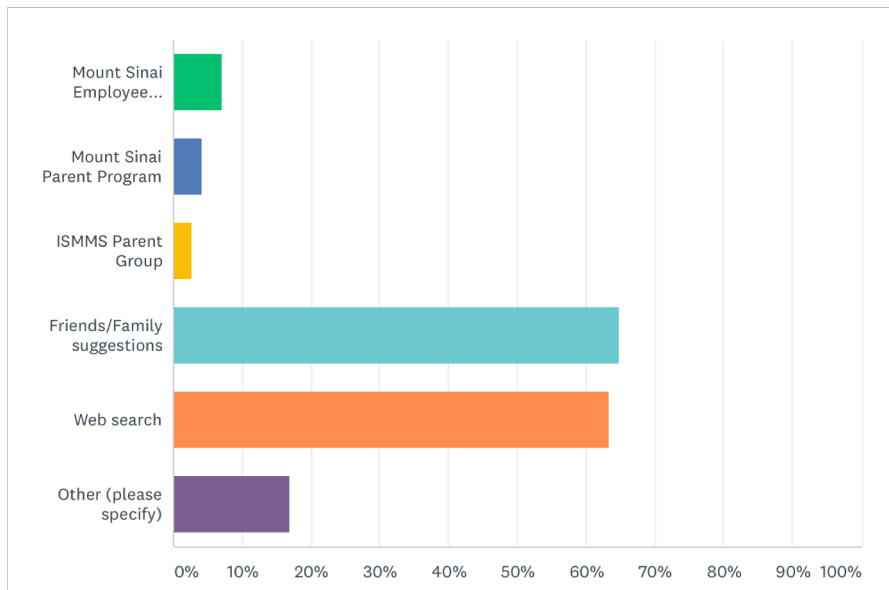

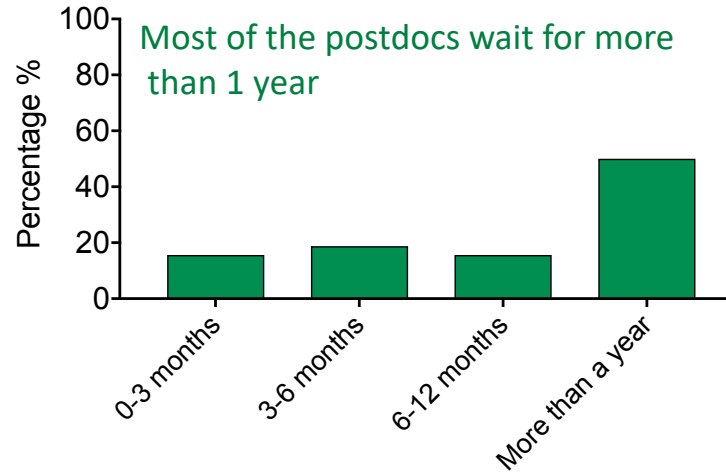
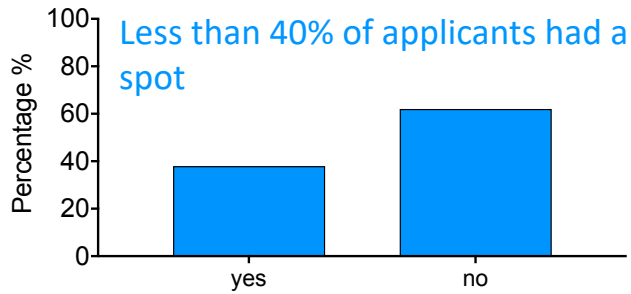
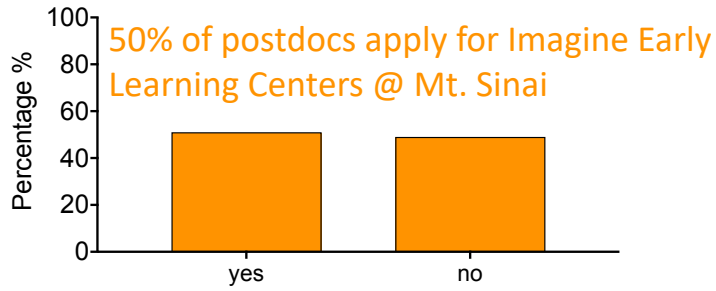
More than 60% postdocs and students found daycare information by family/friends and web search



No help from Mount Sinai to have information



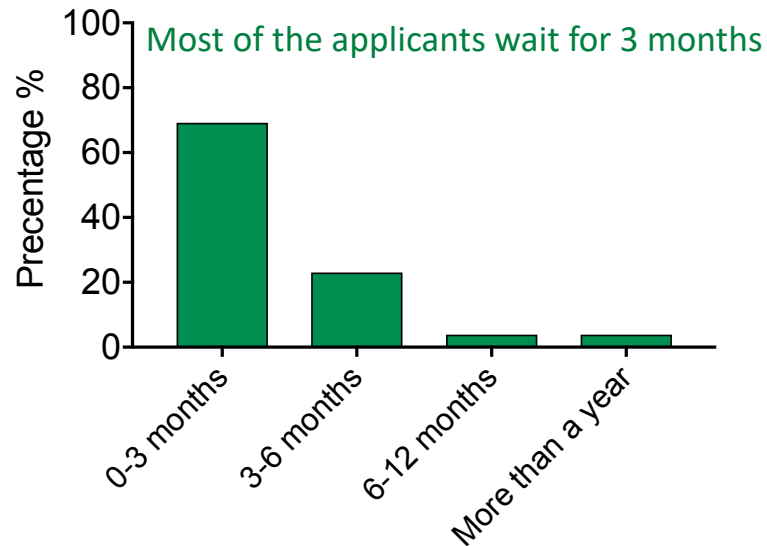
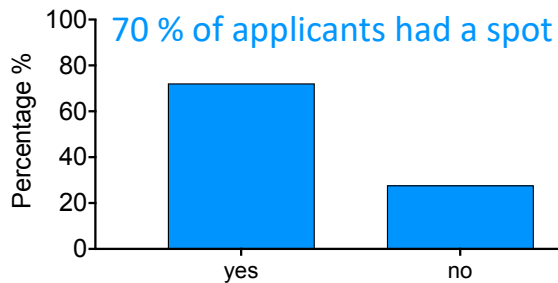
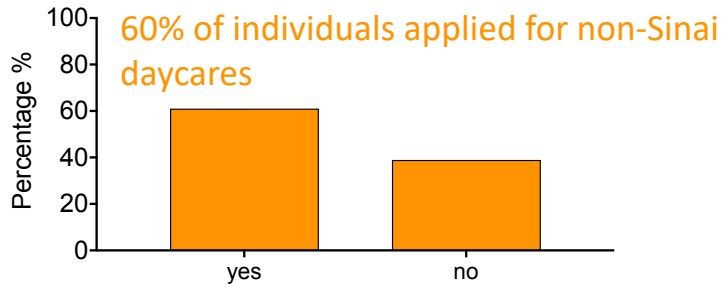

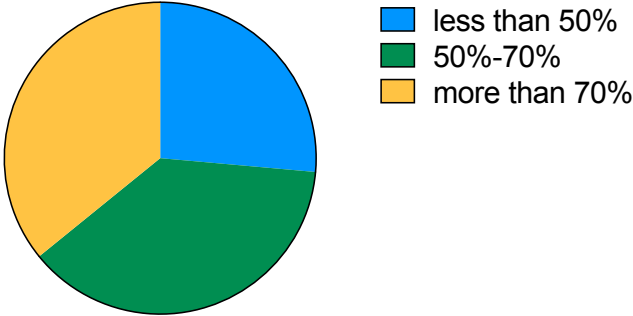
Backup care and Salary



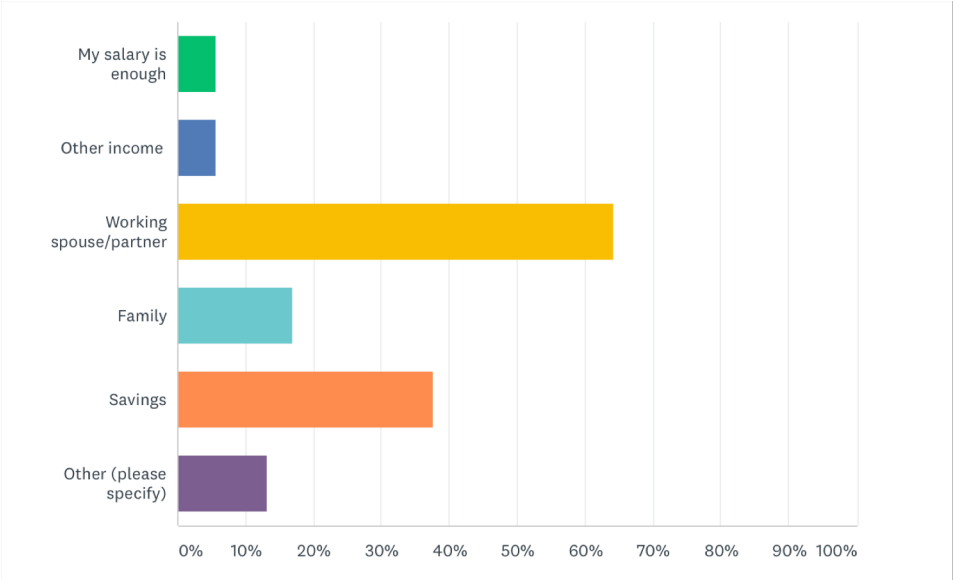
Options used to manage daycare/schools closed

Most of the help come from partner salary (more than 60%) or savings (more than 35%)

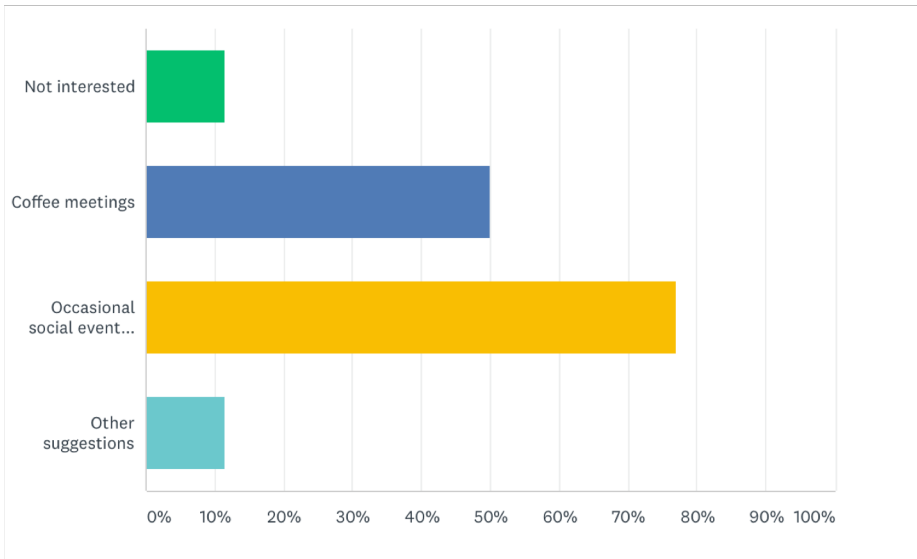


The salary is
