Updates from the Deans ~10 mins

- 1. Basil Hanss, Senior Associate Dean for Student Affairs and Career Development
 - a. General updates
 - b. Student survey results
 - i. Comprehensive survey: students would like increased fellowship advertisement from grad school. Potential solution: having a list of fellowships on a website (NIH or private); GCO has a list of current fellowships held by students. Even a website of a list of examples would be helpful + list of training grants available at Sinai.
 - ii. Mistreatment: largest category of perpetrators is students → try to dissect this further; where is this occurring? Labs? Living areas?
