• Welcome the new MD/PhD representative to PLM, Christian Stevens

Feedback Form Discussion Alexandra Magee, Anina Lund (15 minutes)

- Ally and Anina absent, so Carisse handled feedback
- PhD students should be able to get \$1.85 towards all Sinai food options
- IT should be more professional in supporting employee to student transitions
 - Transition is dictated by the relationship between the particular department and graduate school → it all depends on how terminations are handled by each department; there is no standard operating procedure
 - Sally: Send Matt email about writing a blurb for the newsletter
- Move-in stipend: This is happening?
 - Sally: Email Matt about confirmation for future roll-out
- PhD salary \rightarrow wait until january mark to officially release details
 - Postdocs haven't been given across-the-board bonuses and were dependent on the departments and PIs
 - Postdocs are not eligible for the healthcare subsidy
- School should consider an equivalent housing subsidy so that students have access to affordable housing options
- PhD Program Manager usually orients students to direct deposit set-up prior to students starters, but the PPM didn't exist → this will be addressed in future years
- Look at NIH graduate program vacation days to push for an increase in minimum vacation time allotted in Student Handbook
- International students having issues with IPO and Payroll Dpt
 - SSN: IPO will get them letters for the SSN and then it is left up to the SS Office
 - Brad has been speaking to IPO about this issue
 - There have been some staffing changes in the IPO that likely contributes to the disconnect with students
 - Medicare and SS are being taken out of international student paychecks and the deducted FICA taxes are not being refunded
 - For all students, can Student Affairs work on mediating the conversations between students and Payroll? Getting a list of student names who are experiencing issues gives the Office leverage to make actionable change
 - Mack will make Google Form to collect information from students on financial issues to supply the Office of SA

- Matthew: Are PIs being reminded to fill out rotation evaluations so that students don't have to email them multiple times?
- Pre-tax commuter credits and/or help for purchasing for Metrocards? Likely won't happen but maybe we can work a relationship with the MTA to get commuter credits? There are examples of this in other universities
